

## The History of the Establishment of the Women's Research Center

Alzahra University Women's Research Center\_established in 1997\_ is the first scientific-research center with the affirmation of Higher Education Development Council aiming at organizing research in the field of women and providing implementation strategies to relevant officials. This research center started working on March 22th 1998.



### Women's Research Center establishment purposes

- 1. Explaining the beneficial situation of women according to the values of Islam through using the results of basic and applied research.
- 2. Understanding the current situation of women in various fields and providing basic and practical solutions to remove obstacles.
- 3. Providing a suitable environment to improve the status of women in society.
- 4. Examining women's specific biomedical problems.






### **Facilities of Women's Research Center**




The Journal of Women's Social-Psychological Studies pursues the following goals by publishing scientific articles in the field of women:
